Job Purpose and Mandate: Under the direction of the Golf Course Superintendent and/or the General Superintendent, the Greenskeeper/Operator:

- Operates motorized equipment used on the golf course in an efficient, safe manner;
- Works on a diverse range of activities involved in golf course turf maintenance;
- Does semi-skilled maintenance and construction work;
- Assist with irrigation and performs some general maintenance; and
- Performs related tasks as required.

Duties: Within the limits of authorized policies, procedures, programs and budgets:

- Operates light powered equipment in the maintenance of the golf course greens, tees, fairways and roughs;
- Operates multi-unit hydraulic mowers and/or tractor drawn rotary mowers;
- Operates tractors with and without loaders for moving soil, debris, and mowing;
- Maintains, lubricates, and makes minor adjustments to equipment;
- Grades and prepares a soil plant-bed, lays sod, plants vegetative material, seeds greens, tees, and fairways;
- Changes hole locations and tee markers;
- Maintains ball washers:
- Rakes and maintains bunkers:
- Operates and controls the irrigation and transfer pump systems;
- Helping with project work when necessary;
- Emptying the garbage and recycling bins on the golf course and around the clubhouse; and
- Other duties that arise or as may be assigned.

Requirements:

- Knowledge of safe, efficient mechanical operation of mowers, tractors, and other motorized equipment;
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written directions;
- Ability to organize and appropriately interact with staff;
- Computer skills; and
- Possess a valid driver's licence.
